Summer Fair

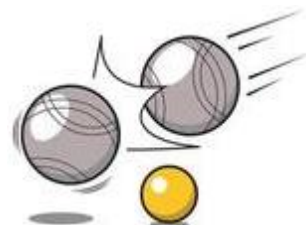

Bookings for Breakfast and After School Club



Please ensure that you book any wraparound care needs in good time. The breakfast and after school club are getting booked up fast and due to staffing ratios, we can only take 20 children at a session.

You can book up to 24 hours in advance but if you are booking on the day, you will need to contact the school office. Please note that if you are booking on the actual day you need provision, we may not be able to guarantee a place. We now ask that you book and pay for your places on School Money. The only exemption to this is if you pay by childcare vouchers where you are able to reserve the slot. If you are paying by childcare vouchers, you must have let us know in advance of reference numbers and providers.
