Strike Action

As mentioned on Class Dojo this week there is national strike action by some teacher unions next Wednesday 1st February which means that some classes are likely to be closed for the day.

As a school we are required to complete risk assessments and the closure of classes is based on whether there are enough qualified and experienced staff to safely supervise and educate the pupils.

Where this is not the case we will close the class and will set remote learning via Class Dojo.

We will let you know as soon as we are made aware of any classes that may be closing but we advise you to seek alternative childcare arrangements for that day, should your child's class be one to close.

Those on Free School Meals in closed classes can collect a packed lunch from the school main entrance on the day between 11.30am and 1pm.
