A huge well done to all the classes, staff and families for a wonderful first half of our Summer term.

Some of the things we have done:

- We have had a brilliant 'Outdoor Classroom' day when we had an OPAL open afternoon for our parents to come and see what OPAL is all about.
- We have continued to enhance our children's outdoor experience with a new climbing frame, art area, digging area and other zones to support their outdoor learning.
- Year 6 have been 'digging for victory' with Mrs Wheatland on a Thursday morning in the outdoor garden area (linked to their topic on World War 2).
- We have continued to develop our Open Doors Curriculum and implement the new Phonics Shed scheme for our children to help them with their reading.
