### Queen Elizabeth II

This morning we spent time in assembly considering the sad passing of Queen Elizabeth II. We had a prayer followed by one minutes silence in assembly and we also remembered the Queen's remarkable life as an example to the world.

She lived out many of the values that we try to encourage in our children at Seven Stars including her remarkable kindness to others, sense of responsibility right to the end, her tolerance of and respect for so many, and her outstanding resilience through many challenging times over the nation's history and in her own personal circumstances. We will keep parents informed of any future events that we plan for the children to mark this historic and sad passing of the Queen and will let you know how we intend to celebrate her amazing life and example over the next few days and weeks.

We will also let you know if there will be any school closures once we have been told. The school remains open unless you hear otherwise. Children have also been thinking about her life in their class activities and there are lots of resources on-line if you want to do further work with the children at home as the country and commonwealth transitions from Queen Elizabeth II to King Charles III. This is a truly historic moment but is also a deeply sad time for many people and in particular the family at the heart of this.

It was so nice to see all our happy smiling children returning to school or in the case of our Reception and Nursery new starters beginning their exciting adventure at Seven Stars School. Well done for getting them to school bright and early and we look forward to a brilliant year ahead.
