Yoga and PE

HELPING AT HOME

In the Moon class, we are encouraging the children to be more independent. Please continue to help your children with these skills:

- 1. Managing clothing putting on and taking off coats, jumpers, socks, shoes.
- 2. Early Reading going to the library, sharing books at home, talking about pictures and handling books carefully.
- 3. Turn taking playing turn taking games that involve following simple rules eg. My turn, your turn, lotto games, and knowing it is OK to wait.

MATHEMATICS

We will continue to sing number rhymes and songs, using our number knowledge to find out how many things we have and how many are left. We will be learning to subitise (the ability to instantly recognise amounts up to 3, without counting). We will also be developing our size vocabulary.

TOPIC

Our topic is "Brilliant Beasts". We will be finding out about different animals and sorting them into groups. We will be making choices about which animals would make good pets and which animals would not, and trying to give reasons. We will be finding out about different ways people celebrate, including Chinese New Year, Easter etc.
