HELPING AT HOME

Top tips for reading at home:

- Look at the front cover and read the title to your child.
- Encourage your child to look at each picture.
- Give your child time to discuss or talk about what is happening on the pictures.

<u>Literacy</u>

During literacy sessions we will be reading and retelling stories such as The Little Red Hen, Snail and the Whale and Whatever Next. We are beginning to write labels for pictures linked to our stories.

Mathematics

Developing a strong grounding in number is essential so that all children develop the necessary building blocks to excel mathematically. This half term we have introduced Number land. Number land is the place where numbers live. Each number is introduced and explored in different ways through a variety of questions and tasks.

TOPIC

This half term, are focusing on the topic of 'Journeys and adventures'. We will be learning about different types of vehicles from the past and present, looking at maps of the local area and building boats out of junk modelling materials and testing whether they float or sink.
