## HELPING AT HOME

Rockets Class have all been given a reading book. Please try to read a few pages with your child every night. We will change reading books every Thursday.

Top tips for reading at home:

- Find a quiet and comfortable spot.
- Look at the front cover and read the title to your child.
- Encourage your child to look at each picture.
- Give your child time to discuss or talk about what is happening on the pictures.

#### Literacy

During literacy sessions we will be reading and retelling stories such as What the Lady Bird heard, Handa's hen and Rumble in the Jungle. We are beginning to write simple sentences.

#### **Mathematics**

Developing a strong grounding in number is essential so that all children develop the necessary building blocks to excel mathematically. This term we will be learning how to add and subtract using a part, part whole diagram. We will be comparing numbers and consolidating learning in shape, space and measures.

### TOPIC

This term, are focusing on the topic of 'Our Colourful World'. We will be learning about the life cycle of different animals, comparing England to other countries, looking at farming tools used today and in the past and learning about the season of summer.
