<p><u>Participation</u> We want to teach our children that taking part is important in all lessons and in all aspects of learning. We want all our children to be kind to each other, to everyone in their world and to themselves. We teach kindness as a key skill for life and we help them develop the habits of kindness that ensure they are positive citizens of the world.</p>	<p><u>Be Ready</u> It is essential our children learn the skills of independence so they are ready for school and life. We teach them the importance of good attendance, being in school on time, having the correct uniform and PE kits, getting plenty of rest so they are able to concentrate, having the equipment they need for learning and so much more. Being ready is a skill that will prepare them for life in school and beyond.</p>
<p><u>Concentration</u> We want our children to grow in their ability to focus on their learning and to learn how to manage distractions. In a society where there are so many things to distract us the skill and ability to concentration is something we all need to work hard at developing</p>	<p><u>Resilience</u> Without struggle we do not advance. We want our children to learn how to develop a growth mind-set that enables them to 'bounce back' in adversity and in the face of challenge. To learn from mistakes and set-backs, and to build their 'resilience muscles' that will help them keep going no matter what.</p>	<p><u>Be Respectful</u> Respect is linked to kindness and is about the way our children conduct themselves in class, in school, in society and throughout life. To show others respect regardless of differences in backgrounds, beliefs or opinions. To learn how to be polite, to listen, and to care (including on-line!) is a much-needed skill today.</p>
<p><u>Pride</u> We want our children to take pride in their work whatever that is. Whether it is their handwriting, the presentation of their work, improving their outcomes or skills of independence. It could be improving skills in PE or Music or pride in their attitude to learning. In all of it we want to instil in them all sense of pride (and understand what this means and why it is important for now and for life)</p>	<p><u>Courage</u> We know that courage is crucial for our children in every aspect of life. Whether facing a challenge in their learning (such as attempting a somersault or taking part in a big match) or in performance (such as singing in front of others) or in life (going for interviews or doing something new). We will teach our children the skills needed to face their fears and 'do it anyway'!</p>	<p><u>Be Safe</u> We want our children to understand how they can keep themselves and others safe at all times.
