**LITERACY** - This half term we will be looking at Myths and Legends. We will be exploring reoccurring themes found in various Greek Myths and analysing the key features in order to write our own. We will also be using persuasive language to create Holiday brochures for travelling to Crete on Holiday.

NUMERACY We use the Red Rose Lancashire scheme for our Maths lessons. We will be using a variety of equipment to help us understand place value. We will develop our written methods and mental calculations. We will also be focusing on times table's knowledge and ensuring that the children are able to quickly recall their times tables. Another big focus in maths will be ensuring that the children are constantly solving problems and challenging themselves.
