Welcome to Year 2! Our topic for this term is 'London'. Through our geography and history, we will find out some facts about London now, the Great Fire of London, Samuel Pepys and his famous diary and also, the deadly plague. PSHE

We will continue to do phonics and spelling at 9:10am every morning so it is crucial children are in school on time.

MATHS

In maths, we use the Red Rose Mastery scheme for all children. Please support your child at home by speaking positively about maths, thinking about when we use maths in real life, counting forwards and backwards in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10.
