Spellings are practiced every day in school but if you want to practice at home also, they are put up on Dojo weekly. Finally please find as much time as you can to practice your times tables. We will be revising all times table in a mixed format so the children are prepared for their times table test. Please do practice any you are not confident with.

English - Now we have finished our latest novel, The Firework Maker's Daughter, we are moving onto none-fiction work. The children will be reading many types of information texts. They will be able to identify the different formats and features of information texts and making their own fact page based on Japan. We will also be having a go at studying and creating our own kenning poems.

Maths We will be completing our final place value unit first which will tie up our understanding of decimal numbers. We will be ordering and comparing, rounding and placing decimal numbers on number lines. We will also be making sure we are confident with all our written and mental methods for addition and subtraction. The children need to be able to choose the best method for working out a calculation. We will be finishing the year completing some fractions work making sure the children are confident finding fractions of amounts and equivalent fractions.
