PSHE

Our main themes for the term are Families, Relationships, and safe relationships. The children will be encouraged to think about their feelings, the feelings of others and to consider their own motivation and attitude.

HELPING AT HOME

Reading regularly at home is really important. Even 10 minutes every night in the week will help many children progress more quickly. We will also send home weekly spellings for the children to practice.

English

We will focus on reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. This term we will use Macbeth by William Shakespeare to support our work, particularly about Narrative and information texts, as part of our 'Terrible Tudors' theme. We will investigate how the author of a story describes the setting and develops the characters in a story.

Maths

In Leo we will be using Red Rose Maths
Mastery to develop the children's basic number
skills, counting and understanding place value of
numbers. We will learn to explain different
ways in which answers can be developed and
help the children to solve problems involving
addition, subtraction and multiplication, as well
as solving real life problems. We will also be
working on the language related to numeracy.

Theme

The Tudors

The children will learn about the Tudors-The Kings and Queens; what life was like in England at that time.

The children will find out about the new topic by using a range of different sources of information.
