Payments to School

place. We currently cannot take any more than 25 children due to staffing/pupil ratios and are fully booked in advance on some days. Please make sure you do not leave it too late to book a place. Places must be booked by calling the school office. Our current charge is a very reasonable £5 per child until 5.30pm which includes a snack.
