If you have taken your child to the GP Surgery to be vaccinated please contact the Immunisation Team on: 0333 3583397 (Option 5: East Lancs/Bwd Imms Team or Option 6: Central Lancashire Imms Team) – This will ensure that the child's consent form is removed from the catch up folder to prevent the child from being vaccinated again.
