Action – What next:

2. Compost bins placed next to the bins on both playgrounds to encourage composting.
3. Black bin liners are used for general waste and clear bags used for recycling bins.
4. Food Ambassadors to address food waste. How can we reduce the amount of food not eaten at lunch?
5. Eco Squad to make posters to place around the school and website.
6. Carry out another waste audit in 3 months to see if there has been an improvement.
