The children will be following the RWI scheme for phonics, a scheme which will continue as they move further up the school. They will learn to recognise set 1 sounds, as well as blending and segmenting words containing these phonemes. The children will also be consolidating Phase 1 skills by playing lots of games

Over the next few weeks, your child will receive their first reading book to share with you at home. Initially each child will start by taking a book home with no words. This is a great opportunity for your child to develop their story telling skills.

Once your child speedily reads the first letter sounds and is blending sounds together at school they will be given a RWI sound blending book.

Books will be sent home each Tuesday and collected in every Monday morning. Therefore, your child will have their book at home from Tuesday to Monday. Please make sure you write in your child's Reading Record each time you hear them read.
