Mrs Hall welcomed everyone to the meeting. We began by reviewing the introduction of Playground Boxes. Year groups from 2 to 6 now all have a box of equipment to use. Mrs Hall asked for feedback about these and everyone agreed

that the classes are really enjoying having toys to play with! Ilyas said that everyone is much happier at playtime. At present, we have just used toys that we already had in school but when we have our fundraising activity, we will be able to choose some new equipment. There have been a few issues with children crowding around the boxes and not sharing equipment so we discussed the best way to encourage positive behaviour. We decided to introduce house point stickers for children who wait their turn, share equipment and are kind to one another. These stickers will be given out by the School Councillors during the afternoon break.

She will discuss this with Mrs Wilson and thanked the older children for their patience with this matter.
