Some of the Councillors had experienced problems with scary adverts popping up – this had happened on YouTube and we discussed the way that this cannot be controlled. One of the Councillors suggested that everyone use Kids YouTube.

Some Councillors were shocked by the age ratings for apps and we agreed that it would be helpful to put all the age ratings on the leaflet so that everyone would be aware of these.

Safety measures discussed by the Councillors included:

Keeping your password safe

Making your password strong

Declining any friend requests unless you can be COMPLETELY sure of who is sending them
