The Federation took a record 81 children from KS2 to the Cross Country Regional Finals! Well done to all involved, not only did they compete to their best, but they also represented school brilliantly at the biggest event since lockdown! Both schools performed to an outstanding standard and we are pleased to announce the results tables.

The criteria to qualify were as follows:

- As each child crossed the finish line, they were given a number to represent their finishing position in the race.
- These numbers were then added together, meaning that the lower the total, the better they finished overall and the higher up the leader board the team would be.
- The top five school teams in each race would qualify for the Leeds City Finals - to be held sometime in February.
- If a team didn't qualify, individual runners could still qualify for Leeds Finals if they finished among the top 5 ranked runners within the teams who missed out on a top five place.
- There were 8 races in total, meaning both Bramham and Shadwell each had a team in each one.
