I can count on and back in 10s and 1s from any given number (below 3 digits)

By the end of this term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for ALL children to be able to recall these facts instantly.

✓ Count on and back in 10s and 1s from any 2 digit number:

23, 33, 43, 53...... 97, 87, 77, 67 86, 87, 88, 89 54, 53, 52, 51

Key Vocabulary:

What do I add to 5 to make 15?
What is 17 take away 10?
What is 10 less than 45?
How many more than 8 is 88?

add, more than, total, altogether, subtract, take away, less than

✓ I can add and subtract two digit numbers mentally

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

<u>Practical</u> – write out a single digit and keep adding 10 – explain what is happening – 2,12,22,32,42....... Once secure count backwards in 10s – explaining the pattern.
