Friday 13th January Arrangements

Please use the side gate which is located by the right hand side of the car park past the clothing bank as the usual side gate is still flooded at the time of writing this. Some people call this gate the garden gate.

Drop off – 08:45 – 09:30 – Staggered. Please drop your child off at any point during this 45 minutes and if you can come later please do, so that the car park does not get too busy as the lower end of it still has some resting water.

Pick up – 14:30 – 15:15 – Staggered. Please pick up your child from the same gate as the morning. We will have the classes ready in the corridor as follows;

2:30 – 2:45 – **EYFS/1/2**

2:45 – 3:00 – **3-4**

3:00 – 3:15 – **5/6**

(if you have siblings, we will make sure the older ones are ready with their younger siblings)

I do hope the above makes sense and in the morning Mrs Burke and myself will be out and about to help make sure children are safely getting into school.
