



Maths

This term in maths, we will be diving into the world of fractions, decimals, and percentages, exploring how they relate to each other and how to use them in various calculations. Following that, we'll shift our focus to geometry, where we'll learn about different shapes and how to calculate their perimeter and area.

PE

Science

This term, we will be exploring Scientists and Inventors. We will be delving into a variety of discoveries and inventions such as Charles Darwin's theory on evolution and Alexander Bell's invention of the telephone.

English

Our English we will be writing a range of text types including writing a biography and a diary entry. We will be focusing on developing the structure of a sentence to improve the content. In Guided Reading and English, this term will all be based on a book called "Street Child" by Bernie Doherty. Guided Reading, we will spend some time practicing our summarising, recall and vocabulary skills using chapters from the book.

History

This term, we will be learning about the Victorians. We will discuss significant historical figures and find out about the legacies they have left. We will spend a day at Sevington Victorian school allowing us to experience a day in the life of a Victorian child.

Music

In music, we are exploring pitch, structure, texture, and staff notation, develop musical composition skills, sing and play with confidence, and perform in ensembles.

French

Our French focus this term is on clothing. We will learn general vocabulary, further explore feminine and masculine sentence construction, and speak and write in sentences about our clothing.

Computing

Computing will focus on how a database can be used to organise data in records. Pupils use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data. They create graphs and charts from their data to help solve problems. They use a real-life database to answer a question, and present their work to others.

PSHE

In PSHE, our next unit is called 'Healthy Me'. We will be explaining the different roles that food has on peoples' lives. We will be looking at different ways to respect ourselves and keep our bodies healthy.
