- **JIGSAW – Healthy Me**
- I will play co-operatively in groups and develop role-play activities with my friends.
- I will be working with others during group activities.
- I will be taking turns when playing games, including tabletop football and animal matching games.

Physical Development

- I will be using the large outdoor apparatus to climb, crawl and balance.
- I will be developing my independence by changing for PE.
- I will develop my gross motor skills by manoeuvring stackable crates, hoops and tyres.
- I will be developing my fine motor movements through a variety of finger-strengthening activities.

Mathematical Development

- I will be using vocabulary to compare groups of objects, e.g. more and fewer.
- I will order jungle animals by height and length.
- I will continue to work on counting and recognising numbers within 5.
- I will be developing my understanding of positional language.
- I will talk about the patterns I notice when making fruit animals for snack.

Communication and language

- I will express my ideas and points of view when looking at pictures of jungle animals.
- I will ask and answer questions about animals.
- I will be taking part in Supersonic Phonic Friends activities aspect 5/6. These aspects focus on hearing alliteration and voice sounds.

Expressive Arts Development

- I will be experimenting with different materials and paint to create animal patterns.
- I will be exploring sound using instruments, including instruments I have made with junk modelling.
- I will be recreating stories I have learnt.
- I will perform known songs and poems with my classmates.

Literacy

- I will develop an understanding of the way stories are structured by learning to sequence 'Walking through the Jungle'.
- I will be developing my name writing.
- I will be drawing pictures of jungle animals and attempting to label them.
- I will be sharing books that I enjoy with my friends and adding to our 'favourites' book box.

Understanding the World

- I will comment on how animals change as they grow.
- I will be looking at lifecycles of animals.
- I will learn information about wild animals and help to make a class fact file about tigers.
- I will be observing the wildlife in our Nursery garden and using books to find out information about them.
- I will explore websites with my teacher so that I can learn more information about animals, including San Diego Zoo and RSPB.
