




# Aged 3 - 5 WEEKLY INSTRUCTIONS WEEK 9


# **Monday**

You can then have a go at the counting objects game. Listen to the question then find the picture with the correct number of objects.




If you can go for a walk, look around you for any signs of Spring. Can you see any flowers growing?




### **Tuesday**

After that, you can have a go at creating your own flower picture. Use the different coloured pens to make different flower patterns.




Remember to eat a healthy snack today and try to do some exercise!




# **Wednesday**

After that, you can make your own Spring picture. Use the different textured pens to draw flowers and trees.




Hopefully, the sun is shining, and you will be able to enjoy the season of Spring today.




### **Thursday**


