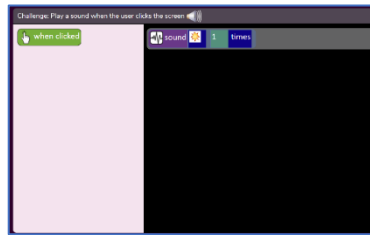
After you have read the first chapter, there are some activities to check your understanding of the story and some questions for you to choose the correct missing words and joining words. There are then two fun activities. First, there is a jigsaw to complete. Then you can have a go at designing some sports clothes for Anna.



In maths, you have a game to play called Bond Bubbles. Have a go at doing challenge A first. You need to find your number bonds up to 20. If you want to challenge yourself, have a go at Challenge B. Here, your target number increases.



Finally, there is a chance to develop your coding skills and write some code for the activity 'Sounds'. Can you complete the code to play a variety of different sounds?



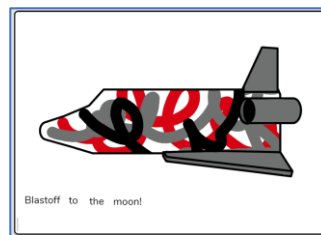
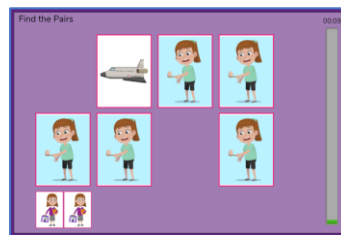
Make sure you give yourself time to do some exercise today!

Tuesday

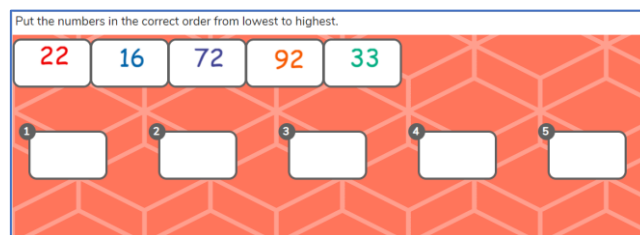
Today we are going to read chapter 2 of our story, 'Anna's Sportsday', and then do some work to check your understanding. In today's chapter, Anna meets someone quite surprising who offers to help her get ready for sports day.



After completing the understanding and word activities, there is a pairs game to help you remember some scenes from the story so far. In the story, Anna is learning all about Spaceships, but she isn't in the mood to paint her spaceship. Can you help Anna?



In maths today, you have an ordering numbers quiz. Look at the numbers and put them in order from the lowest number to the highest number.



In this week's topic work, just like Anna, we are going to be looking at Space! First of all, you are going to imagine that you are an astronaut. Using the mash cam, write down and draw your feelings about being an astronaut. You might want to write about what you do, why you enjoy it, and what you see when you go into space. Then, there is a space game for you to play! Can you collect up all the space fossils before the aliens catch you? If you can, have a go at making your own level 3.





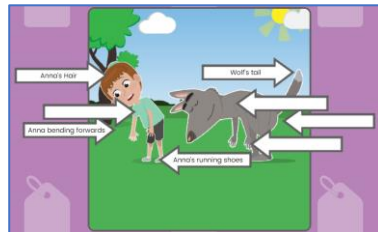
Well done! Remember to get some fresh air today and have a healthy lunch.

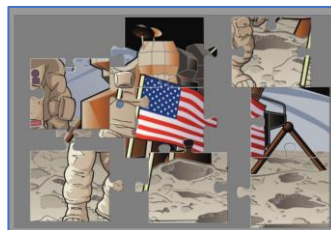
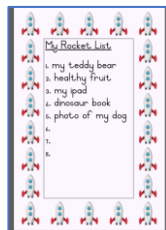


In maths, you are playing a 2race game today. Can you find one more or one less than a given number to win the race?

Thursday

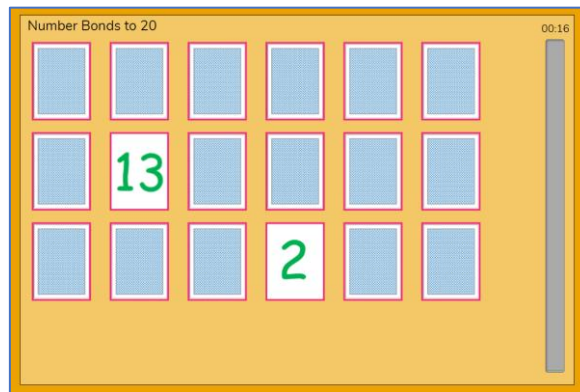
In today's chapter of our story, sports day has finally arrived, but Anna is still not feeling very confident.



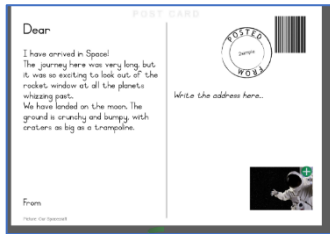
