



<u>Aged 7 - 9</u> WEEKLY INSTRUCTIONS WEEK 11

<u>Monday</u>

Welcome to the start of the week. Everyone at Purple Mash hopes you had a good weekend and stayed safe. Today, we continue our story – *The Last Selkie*. In chapter 2, Raveena and Fionn the cat learn more about Gad's tricky situation.



After reading the chapter, there is a comprehension activity to show how much of the chapter you have understood. For the extended writing activity, write a poem about sounding confident but feeling nervous.

In maths, you are going to race against the computer in 2Race as you show your knowledge of addition and subtraction up to 100. Remember the more questions you get correct the quicker your racer will travel.



For our topic work this week we have a number of activities based around the theme of animals.



Today you are going to write about your favourite animal and then draw and colour a picture of it using 2Paint a Picture.



Remember to set some time aside for PE to ensure you keep fit. This could be a run around the garden, a brisk walk with your mum or dad or watching a keep fit routine on the Internet.



<u>Tuesday</u>

Today we continue our short story and then do some work to check how well you have understood it. In today's chapter, whilst searching for the missing comb, Raveena and Gad meet a Granite Monster. After reading the chapter and completing the comprehension, create an annotated diagram to describe Raveena.

In maths, you are going to be predict whether the answer to a mathematical question is odd or even. Remember to look closely at the units to help you get the answer right.

In today's activity linked to animals, there are two pieces of work looking at herbivores (animals that eat plants), carnivores (animals that eat meat) and omnivores (animals that eat plants and meat). Can you get all the answers correct?





Remember to spend some time exercising and eating healthy food.



<u>Wednesday</u>

Today we are halfway through the week and you are working well. In Literacy, we are going to read the next chapter of our short story, *The Last Selkie*. In today's chapter, Raveena and her friends meet the Queen and then go hunting for the seal skin.

After completing the comprehension, it is time for some extended writing. Will Old Ma get her sealskin back? Write the next part of the story.



In maths, we use our knowledge of number facts to divide numbers by 10. Can you get them all right?



For our topic work on animals will our looking at minibeasts. There is a database on minibeasts with some questions for you to answer. To complete this exercise, you will need two tabs open. One tab will have the quiz showing and the other the database. To help you answer the questions, you can use the table view, the find function and the sort, group and arrange function. After this, you will use an outline of a minibeast to design your own creature. Where will it live, what will it eat, how many legs will it have? Don't forget to give it a name.





As on previous days, remember to set some time to make sure you move and eat a healthy lunch.



<u>Thursday</u>

In today's final chapter of our story, Raveena meets with Old Ma and presents her with her sealskin. Old Ma disappears. Show how well you understand what you have read by completing the comprehension activity.

For the extended writing, now that you have finished reading The Last Selkie, write a review of the story.



In maths, you will be labelling a fraction line with the correct fractions.



Today as we finish our work on animals with two activities, as we think about where they live. Firstly, there is a pairs game where you have to match the animal to its home and then a writing activity where you select 3 animals and write about where they live.



Hopefully, the weather is sunny, and you can get outside for some exercise.



<u>Friday</u>

Today, you are going to start reading a new story called '*Settlers*' which is set in the stone age. In today's opening chapter, Ash is disappointed that his family have chosen to settle down but when a terrifying beast threatens their home, danger is immediately at hand. After you have read the chapter and answered the comprehension questions, there is some extended writing to complete. Ash was not feeling happy that his family was making plans to settle down. Pretend you are Ash and write a diary account about your day, including your thoughts and feelings about being a settler.



In maths, you will need to be using your timestables knowledge to grow your monster in Monster Multiplication. Remember the more answers you get correct then the faster your monster will grow. How quickly can you help him change appearance?



Today we are going to write some code to create and run functions. Can you manage to complete the activity? Don't forget to use the hints if you need some help.
