Monday

Welcome to the start of the week. Everyone at Purple Mash hopes you had a great weekend. Today we continue to read the novel 'Horde of Ravens', our story set in Roman Britain. In today's chapter, Queen Boudica comes to Conan's village. Conan's father tells him the Romans have betrayed the Iceni, and now their tribe will join the Iceni in a revolt against the Romans.



After reading the story, there is a comprehension exercise to complete and for the extended writing: Conan said that he used to enjoy campfires when chiefs and elders would tell stories from the tribe's past. Write a short story that could be told at a campfire.

In maths, it is time to race against the computer playing a game of 2Race. Today you will be comparing numbers up to 100,000. Remember the more correct answers you give, the quicker the racer will move, and you will win the race.



It is then time for some coding. In today's exercise you need will write some code linked to a football match. Remember to use the hint videos if you need some extra support.



Remember to set some time aside for PE to ensure you keep fit. This could be a run around the garden, a brisk walk with your mum or dad or watching a keep fit routine on the Internet.



Tuesday

In today's chapter of our story, Conan and his uncle Turi ride over to the Iceni and learn how to make a carnyx, the Celtic war horn that is feared in battle, even by the Romans. After completing the comprehension exercise, now that we have seen Conan react in a range of situations, create a character profile about him. Remember to use evidence from the story to support your opinions.



In maths you will carry out some work involving the four number operations.



For our topic work this week, we are going to complete some activities linked to our story and based around the Romans. Today there is a quiz about the three Roman invasions of England and then a writing frame where you must write a newspaper report about the Roman invasion.






Remember to spend some time exercising and eating healthy food.




Wednesday

For topic work on the Romans, there is a quiz about Roman soldiers and then a writing frame for you to complete about life for a soldier of the Roman empire.





As on previous days, remember to set some time to make sure you and eat a healthy lunch.




Thursday

Today we read the penultimate chapter of 'Horde of Ravens' In the chapter Conan's tribe ride out to hear Boudica's battle plan. She tells them that it's time to attack the capital Camulodunum. After answering the comprehension questions, the in the extended writing when Conan arrived to hear Boudica speak, he was surprised at how many people were there. Use the template to write a poem about the crowds of people and how they behaved.



In maths you are going to do some work on fractions, decimals and percentages.



For the work on the Romans, we are going to look at Roman gods. There is a pairs game where you need to match the god up to the correct description and then there is a writing frame about Roman gods accompanied with some information about the main ones.






Hopefully, the weather is sunny, and you can get outside for some exercise.
