School Dinners

Please be aware of the below for school dinners. As advised by Rochdale council the school dinners will be by increasing to £2.50 per day or 12.50 for the week. There needs to be at least 2 weeks' notice when changing the meal patterns of your child. If less than 2 weeks is given we will not be able to accommodate the meal change due to the kitchen orders.

The school will be in touch with on the below:

- Debts under £25 will receive a text message asking for payment to be made.
- Debts over £25 but under £37.50 will receive an email warning them that if payments are not paid they will be asked to put their child/ren on to pack lunches
- Debts Over £37.50 will contacted via phone call with a follow up email, notifying them that if the debt is not cleared by Monday morning then they will not be allowed to order a school dinner and will have to provide a pack lunch.

Breakfast club and Tea time club

Early Start

Pre-booked places will be charged at £3.30 per morning. If your child is not booked on to Early Start Club then you will be charged £3.50 per morning. Children who arrive at school before 8:20am without an adult will be placed in Early Start club and be charged £3.50 with a phone call home to make sure that you are aware that they are in school. Any debts over £20 will result in the withdrawal of Early Start Club service until the debt is cleared. Parents will be asked to sign their children in with a signature and time.

Tea Time Club

Pre-booked places will be charged at £3.30 per afternoon. If your child is not booked on to Tea Time Club then you will be charged £3.50 per afternoon. If your child is not picked up by 3:25pm they will be placed in Tea Time Club and be charged at £3.50 with a phone call home to make sure that you are aware that they are still at school. Any debts over £20 will result in the withdrawal of Tea Time Club service until the debt is cleared. Parents will be asked to sign their children out with a signature and time.

Swimming

- •a swimming costume and towel

- •an outdoor coat, essential to keep warm travelling back to school after the lesson
- •Your child can bring some fresh fruit to eat at school after their swimming lesson.
