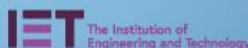

**We can't wait to see you all again!**

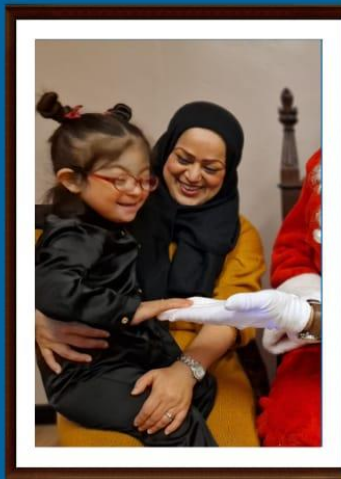
