Swimming

- Yellow Class will be swimming each Wednesday Afternoon from W/C 12th September – 30th January 2023

During this time it will be essential that your child has:

- A swimming cap (Long Hair)
- a swimming costume and towel
- A separate swimming bag for the wet towel and costume.
- Easily removable outer clothing to ease changing into and out of swimming wear
- an outdoor coat, essential to keep warm travelling back to school after the lesson
- Your child can bring some fresh fruit to eat at school after their swimming lesson.
