## Healthy Packed Lunches

#### **Packed Lunch**

If children bring a packed lunch it should be in a clearly labelled lunchbox. The school has produced guidelines about what should be included in a packed lunch.

#### Packed Lunches should include:

A sandwich or equivalent e.g. wrap, rice, salad, pasta salad etc, A drink of water, milk or pure fruit juice, A portion of fruit, A portion of vegetables,

#### A portion of dairy e.g. yoghurt or cheese. Packed Lunches should not include:

Jam or chocolate spread, Fizzy drinks or cordial, Bars of chocolate,

We would ask parents to support this.
