### Medical Information

If you child has Asthma you need to ensure that they have an inhaler with them in school. This needs to be brought to the office so we can ensure that this is on the system.

### Healthy Packed Lunches

#### Packed Lunch

If children bring a packed lunch it should be in a clearly labelled lunchbox. The school produced guidelines about what should be included in a packed lunch.

Packed Lunches should include: A sandwich or equivalent e.g. wrap, rice, salad, pasta salad etc, A drink of water, milk or pure fruit juice, A portion of fruit, A portion of vegetables, A portion of dairy e.g. yoghurt or cheese.

Packed Lunches should not include: Jam or chocolate spread, Fizzy drinks or cordial, Bars of chocolate, Crisps more than once a week
