Maybe you could have a go at writing a list of patients names that are waiting to see the doctor or draw a picture of a lost teddy.</p> <p>Watch the story 'Emergency' by Margaret Mayo https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DjiQBbPMf0</p> <p>Explore the word emergency. What is an emergency? What should you do in an emergency? Can children make up their own emergency sentences? "Emergency!! A car is stuck in the mud" etc...</p> <p>Play some instructional games. If children are happy and it is safe to do so children could be blindfolded and they have to listen carefully and follow the instructions they are given e.g. walk two steps forward, turn around, jump three times etc...</p>	<p>Hide some toys and write some clues for children to follow as police detectives e.g. "Look under the sofa", "Look behind the toy box" can they find all the missing items?</p> <p>Play shops taking it in turn to be the shop keeper have a selection of items for sale possibly toys or fruit and vegetables keep the amounts low at first can the children pay for the item using the correct number of real pennies.</p> <p>Look at images of warning signs talk about the different shapes. Can you make your own warning sign? What shape will your sign be?</p> <p>Practise writing numerals 0-9 Whilst out on your daily walk why not take your list of numbers and see if you can find houses with each number on them and tick them off your list.</p>	<p>'What time is it Mr Wolf'</p> <p>Hopskotch</p>
