- PE will be every Thursday every week and your child will need, shorts, t-shirt and pumps.
- > Please make sure all earrings are removed or covered with a plaster or tape.
- Staff aren't allowed to put on the tape, if brought into school your child needs to do this themselves.

RWI

- A RWI lesson will last for 1 hour.
- It begins with a phonics session. We will be revising set 1 sounds before moving onto set 2 and finally set 3 sounds. It is a good idea to purchase these sound cards for practising at home.
- Your children will move onto a range of reading activities based around a specific coloured book. They begin with red ditty books, then green, purple, pink, orange, yellow, blue and finally grey books.
- They will also complete various writing activities, including, hold a sentence, build a sentence and big writing.
- Your child will bring a ditty or book home every week to practise. They will already have read this book/ditty during their RWI lessons.
- We will also be sending home a 'Book Bag Book' each week. This will be a book that the children have not previously seen.
- Some children will also receive spellings to learn at home each week, later in the year.

Phonics Test June 2024



- The phonics screening check is taken individually by all children in Year 1 in England, and is usually taken in June. It is designed to give teachers and parents information on how your child is progressing in phonics.
- The children will read 40 words that include real and nonsense words and contain set 1, 2 and 3 sounds.





Maths will be a 45 minute session.

Maths

- We will begin the year working on number and place value. This will include, recognising and forming numbers, addition, subtraction and being aware of the value of a number.
- We will also look at shape, space and measures. This will include, 2D and shapes, time, length, weight and money.

All About Me!

- We begin the school year talking about ourselves.
- Your children will have an opportunity to talk about their likes, dislikes and what makes them special.
- They will draw pictures of themselves, on paper and also on the computers.
- We will discuss and label the different body parts and explore what we can use each body part for.
- We will also learn about our 5 senses, sight, smell, touch, hearing and taste by participating in various activities.



Animals



- In this topic we will talk about and find out all about the six animal groups;
- Mammals
- Reptiles
- Amphibians
- Fish
- Birds
- Insects



This usually ends with a parents breakfast based on everything that we have learnt about the six groups.

Plants







- ▶ We will be growing cress and beans.
- Your children will discuss how they will plant the cress and beans and what they will need.
- They will learn about what a plant needs to grow healthily.
- They will be responsible for their own bean/cress, e.g watering it.

Seaside Holidays!

- We will talk about the features of seaside holidays. What would you see if you went to the seaside? What would you do? What would you eat?
- We will link this to seaside holidays in the past. How were they different? How were they similar?





Materials





- Your children will look at the properties of a variety of materials.
- They will participate in an investigation about different materials. This will be, what is the best material to make an umbrella from?
- They will be given the opportunity to plan the investigation thinking about what they will need and predict what they think will happen.
- They will conduct the investigation in groups to answer the question and discover the best material for the job!

How parents can help at home...

- Learning Log This is a book containing one activity that needs to be completed over a two week period.
- Practising sounds with your child. Begin with set 1 and we will inform you when your child begins to learn set 2 and then set 3 sounds.
- Listening to your child read their reading books.
- Counting in 1's to 100 and back again. We will send home a hundred square.
- Helping your child to recognise numbers to 20 and then 100.
