

In **MATHS** we will follow the Year 3 National Curriculum for Maths with a focus on Roman Numerals.

In **ENGLISH**, we will read How To Be A Roman In 21 Easy Ways, write our own Roman myth and we will also look at different types of Poetry.

In SPANISH we will learn about the months of the year, simple greetings and the names of buildings.

In MUSIC we will be learning how to play the recorder in unison.

In PSHCE we will be learning about growing and changing; first aid; healthy lifestyles and collaboration.

In DT we will investigate the properties of clay and produce a Roman Oil lamp. We will also investigate Roman technology including catapults.

In COMPUTING, we will use software to manipulate and create a Roman Mosaic. We will begin to learn how to code using Scratch Junior.

In R.E. we will be investigating why people pray and what it means to be a Christian in Britain today.

In P.E. we will be doing athletics and focusing on techniques to self-improve. We will also be playing tennis, developing serving and batting skills and practising our fielding skills in cricket.

In HISTORY we will be investigating the impact of the Romans on our lives. Using different sources of evidence and a trip to Ribchester Museum, we'll develop our understanding of the Romans and the Celts. **In SCIENCE** we will learn about plants. We will focus on identifying, describing and investigating the functions of different parts of flowering plants and use secondary sources to research what they need to live.

In GEOGRAPHY we will learn about where the Roman Empire developed.

In ART we will look at creating Roman mosaics using various digital packages.
