Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are Changing!

Per Parent, Per Child

First Offence

The first time a Penalty notice is issued for Term Time Leave or irregular Attendance, the amount will be:

- within 28 days. Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

Third Offence and Any

Further Offences (within 3 years) ind time an offence is committed ferm Time Leave or irregular dance a Penalty Notice will not be i, and the case will be presented to the Magistrate's Court.

Consecutive Days of Term Time Leave

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for ferm Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days. INSET training days are school days and can be included in the 5 or more consecutive days where there was intent to be absent for term time leave.






...they also found an elf and a book and Miss Bali read it to everyone. Now there's an Elf in reception!

There's been cheeky elves spotted all over school this week...there's even one in the office peeping over Mrs Choudhry's computer!


