With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the follow changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19th August 2024.

Per Parent, Per Child

nalty Notice Fines will now be issued each parent, for each child that was

First Offence

The first time a Penalty notice is issued for Term Time Leave or irregular Attendance, the amount will be:

- £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.
- within 28 days.
 Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years)

Consecutive Days of Term Time Leave

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for ferm Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days. INSET training days are school days and can be included in the 5 or more consecutive days where there was intent to be absent for term ime leave.

10 sessions of

unauthorised absence in a 10-week period Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period.
