WEATHER

As the weather turns cooler and we are seeing more rain — please ensure that children have a coat in school at all times and a jumper or fleece if required.

WATER BOTTLES

Reminder that ALL children in Phase 3 need a water bottle in school. Please ensure that the water bottle has water in it and NOT juice. Children are only allowed Juice with their dinner.

PICK UP & DROP OFF

Please be aware after recent events, we will/may be asking individuals to identify themselves when picking up and dropping off children. Whether this is at the gate when you press the buzzer to enter or when you exit the school grounds.

We have a lot of new staff in the building and other staff move around to cover different classes. People who pick up your children will not always be recognised by them, even if they have been picking up for a while. Please ensure that your contacts on the pickup lists are up to date. New staff will not recognise older sibling either – they too must be on the pickup list.

Please do not be offended if a member of staff challenges you – this is for the safety and safeguarding of both the children and staff. There are over 400 children in our school and we do not recognise all the parents, siblings and family members.

SCHOOL COMMS/SIMMS

If you are not already on the GATEWAY APP – Download it now!

We would just like to remind you that school use the GATEWAY APP as a means to communicate events and activities and provide a portal for parents to pay/book for items such as tea time club, early start club, trips, dinners, school equipment etc.

Please ensure that you have the app on which ever device you use. Please see below how to register for the app.

If you know of other parents that are not on the GATEWAY App, please urge them to register – it is of benefit to everyone.

To register for the school GATEWAY account you will need to download the school gateway app via App store for Apple devices and/or Play Store for Android devices.

- Go to the login screen on the app
- Enter the same email address and mobile number that is registered with the school
- You will receive an PIN through text
- Enter the 4 digit PIN
- Once logged in, the home screen will be displayed.

SIMs

Similarly, SIMs is used for midterm/end of term reporting. Please ensure you also have SIMs downloaded on your device.

You can only log in to SIMs after an email invitation from school. If you are still not on the SIMs app, please come to the school office and seek assistance
