

Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are Changing! With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the follochanges will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19th August 2024. Per Parent, Per Child 5 Consecutive Days of Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for Term Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days. INSET training days are school days and can be included in the 5 or more consecutive days where there was intent to be absent for term time leave. example; 3 siblings absent for term leave, would result in each parent lying 3 seperate fines. 10 sessions of unauthorised absence **First Offence** in a 10-week period nalty Notice Fines will be considered ten there has been 10 sessions of authorised absence in a 10 week The first time a Penalty notice is issued for Term Time Leave or irregular Attendance, the amount will be:

Second Offence second time a Penalty Notice is d for Term Time Leave or irregular dance the amount will be:

within 28 days.
Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.
