FOOTBALL – Project Sport are sending a coach who will specialise in football skills and who has a passion for the game. They teach the children new skills, as well as supporting them to perfect the skills they have already. This club is for all abilities. Please note that the last session will be 2nd December 2025.

LEGO - "The Bricktopia team have been providing fun and engaging activities, using LEGO bricks, for over ten years. The LEGO builder club encourages children to use their imaginations across several building activities providing inspiration, a chance to work in partnership, and to problem solve whilst having plenty of fun!

We use a variety of building activities across the programme which is tailored to the age, ability, and numbers attending but includes Technic models, LEGO Mosaics, Classic LEGO bricks, marble runs, Bingo! and challenges.

The experienced instructors ensure that all children are supported and encouraged to use their imaginations and be creative ... whilst having fun with LEGO bricks!"

KARATE – Our karate sessions aim to develop your child's physical skills and learn the first stages of karate in a fun, safe and inclusive environment. Sessions are taught by Fay Hanson, 6th Dan, from Kirkburton Karate Club. Fay has been a karate instructor for over 25 years and has taught in both primary and secondary schools for over 20 years. All students receive a certificate at the end of the term and can showcase their work to parents. (The showcase will be on 2nd December 2025 – this will be the final session due to the hall being in use for the Christmas concerts rehearsals and performances)

TEXTILES/CRAFT – A chance to try a range of crafts and techniques and to learn new or develop existing skills. Each term we cover a variety of activities which might include amongst others sewing, weaving, braiding, papercrafts, mixed media projects, painting a variety of objects or making mosaics. Each term is different and generally includes something seasonal. The main aims are to try something new and have fun! Please Note – Mrs Driver has 2 weeks where she is unable to run the sessions in September – we will confirm the weeks as soon as we have the information available.
