After School Clubs Autumn Term 2026

We are pleased to be able to offer several after school clubs again in the Autumn term 26/27.

Please find below a list, along with the cost for the full term and which year groups can access which clubs. These clubs will be available to book via ParentPay. There are a limited number of places available for each club. If you cannot see the club on your ParentPay account, it may mean that all the available places have been booked.

Below are some details on what children can expect should they wish to participate in any of the after-school clubs.





BUSHCRAFT/SURVIVAL – 🌿🗺️🧭

Does your child love exploring the outdoors? Our exciting **Bushcraft After School Club** introduces children to essential wilderness skills in a fun, safe and engaging environment.

Over the course of the programme, pupils will discover what bushcraft is and learn how to make the most of the natural world around them. Activities include identifying animal tracks and signs, developing observation and tracking skills, building shelters from woodland materials, and working together in team-building survival challenges. Children will also learn how to source and store water, move quietly through the environment, understand the basics of camouflage, and develop practical outdoor problem-solving skills. The programme concludes with an introduction to **orienteering**, where pupils will gain confidence using maps and compasses and learn how to navigate their way through the outdoors.

This hands-on club promotes **confidence, teamwork, resilience, communication and a deeper appreciation of nature**, making it the perfect adventure for curious and energetic young explorers.

LEGO - 🧱

"The **Bricktopia** team have been providing fun and engaging activities, using LEGO bricks, for over ten years. The LEGO builder club encourages children to use their imaginations across several building activities providing inspiration, a chance to work in partnership, and to problem solve whilst having plenty of fun!

We use a variety of building activities across the programme which is tailored to the age, ability, and numbers attending but includes Technic models, LEGO Mosaics, Classic LEGO bricks, marble runs, Bingo! and challenges.

SPANISH - 🇪🇸

The Spanish classes are interactive and fun. Children learn the basics of Spanish through games, cultural activities, and creative learning experiences that make learning enjoyable and memorable. Classes are taught by Nancy Garcia, a native Spanish speaker with a First-Class degree in Spanish and English from The Open University (UK) and over 20 years of experience teaching in schools and as a private tutor. She creates a relaxed, encouraging environment where children gain confidence while developing their Spanish language skills.



MULTI-SPORTS 🏆🏀🏈🏊

– At our Multi-Sports Club, children can enjoy a wide range of sports and activities designed to keep them active, engaged, and having fun. Sessions include a mixture of team sports, individual challenges, skill-based games, and fitness activities, giving them the opportunity to try new sports, improve their coordination, and build confidence in a supportive environment. Led by experienced coaches, every session focuses on participation, enjoyment, teamwork, and personal development, helping children develop both physically and socially while making new friends along the way.

CREATIVE ARTS CLUB – 🎨✂️

At this after school club children will have the opportunity to explore the senses, seasons and nature through the creative use of art materials each week. Drawing, painting, printing and pattern making will all be a part of what we do. Children will also be able to enjoy working on their own and take part in exciting group projects both indoors and in the school grounds too.
