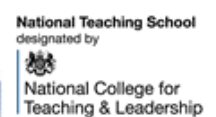

Below are some details on what children can expect should they wish to participate in any of our after-school clubs.

**FOOTBALL** – Project Sport are sending a coach who will specialise in football skills and who has a passion for the game. He teaches the children new skills, as well as supporting them to perfect the skills they have already. His This club is for all abilities.

**STEM CLUB** - Science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Led by our very own Mrs Dempsey, this club uses innovative methods revolving around STEM fundamentals where children build their own working model(s) to keep. On top of building their STEM knowledge, they will also develop construction skills.



**NETBALL** – Our very own Mrs Pinder will be teaching the skills required to play a competitive game of netball, whilst perfecting the skills children already they will definitely learn new skills too. Mrs Pinder has a track record of coaching the Shelley First netball team to victory in the Shelley pyramid netball tournament.

**TEXTILES/CRAFT** – A chance to try a range of crafts and techniques and to learn new, or develop existing skills. Each term we cover a variety of activities which might include amongst others sewing, weaving, braiding, papercrafts, mixed media projects, painting a variety of objects or making mosaics. Each term is different and generally includes something seasonal. The main aims are to try something new and have fun!

**CHEERLEADING** –Project Sport provides skilled sports coaches to teach the children key dancing skills whilst enjoying a fun and engaging session as a team. This club is open to all abilities. There is a performance at the end of the term.

**CREATIVE ARTS CLUB** – At this after-school club children will have the opportunity to explore the senses, seasons and nature through the creative use of art materials each week. Drawing, painting, printing and pattern making will all be a part of what we do. Children will also be able to enjoy working on their own take part in exciting group projects both indoors and (when the weather is warmer) in the school grounds too!
