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SPANISH – Nancy, who has offered the Spanish club for several years in school, delivers a fun club where children learn basic Spanish. Each session focuses on a subject such as numbers, colours, animals and weather etc. For children who have never learnt a new language, this is a fun club to try. Those who have already attended can build on their learning. Children also look forward to the drink and snack provided, too!

FOOTBALL – Damian is a very experienced football coach who has a passion for the game. He teaches the children new skills, as well as supporting them to perfect the skills they have already. His friendly and encouraging manner is brilliant. This is a great club for all abilities.

CHEERLEADING – Project Sport provides skilled sports coaches to teach the children key dancing skills whilst enjoying a fun and engaging session as a team. This club is open to all abilities.

STEM CLUB - Science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. This club uses innovative methods revolving around STEM fundamentals where children build their own model(s) to keep. On top of building their STEM knowledge, they will also develop construction skills.

TEXTILES/CRAFT – A chance to try a range of crafts and techniques and to learn new, or develop existing skills. Each term we cover a variety of activities which might include amongst others sewing, weaving, braiding, papercrafts, mixed media projects, painting a variety of objects or making mosaics. Each term is different and generally includes something seasonal. The main aims are to try something new and have fun!

MINI OLYMPICS – Project Sport provides skilled sports coaches to teach the children key sporting skills whilst enjoying active games in a fun and engaging environment. This is a club for all abilities.

CODING CLUB -Coding is a concept students are familiar with and have completed some work on in previous years. We are excited to offer a coding club using actual robots that children can program and then watch their code come to life! Each child will have use of a robot to code with support and guidance. We will help them master block coding and introduce them to more advanced levels of coding as they progress. This is a great opportunity to help children familiarise themselves with coding, a concept that is growing increasingly popular.

CREATIVE ARTS CLUB – At this after-school club children will have the opportunity to explore the senses, seasons and nature through the creative use of art materials each week. Drawing, painting, printing and pattern making will all be a part of what we do. Children will also be able to enjoy working on their own take part in exciting group projects both indoors and (when the weather is warmer) in the school grounds too!

CHOIR – This club is run by Musica Kirklees. Come along and join in for a sing-a-long and learn new skills to support singing in harmony with fellow singers. You will be creating a beautiful sound before you know it and growing in confidence. The choir can only continue to run next term if we have more interest, so please sign up straight away to be counted in the spring term.



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
