English and Reading

In English lessons we will be focussing on the story of Fox by Margaret Wild. Children will develop their writing by focusing on use of language and sentence formation in a variety of ways with an intended purpose of creating a report on foxes and then creating their own fable narrative. Our reading is focusing on Africa, Amazing Africanwhere children will learn a variety of reading skills linked to VIPERS.

Maths

During maths lessons this half term, we will be focussing on addition and subtraction of 3 digit numbers. We will also be starting to look at multiplication and division. TTRockstars will be vital in helping them succeed with this topic.

Children will also learn their times tables so that they can recall them instantly. It is vital that children know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables before they finish year 3.

TTRockstars will be used to support this.

PSHE

Our PSHE topic for this half term is 'Celebrating Differences'. We will be looking at families, feelings, bullying, kind words and complimenting others.

Grammar



Grammar will be focusing on the formation of nouns using a range of prefixes e.g. auto and -super. We will be looking at expressing time, place and cause using a range of conjunctions. Spelling will focus on previously taught spelling patters and the Year 3

Year 3 Curriculum Overview - Autumn 2




ART/DT
