<u>Year 5 Curriculum Overview- Term 3</u>

ART/DT

In Art and DT we will be drawing and making collages - developing personal style. We are also researching and designing products that aid problems linked to longdistance travel

PSHE

In this unit of work, children will focus on celebrating differences. Fostering a general atmosphere of kindness in our classroom not only helps children improve their social skills, but it also sets them up fantastically for the rest of their life. Teaching children to be proud of their differences while also being respectful towards others can hopefully inspire them to be a positive and kind person when they grow older.



History and Geography

This term the children will be looking at a thematic study of understanding how locations in the world dictates time zone. In history, we will be studying the Ancient Egyptians and what impact they had on life today.

Science

Grammar



In Science the children will be exploring space. They will be describing the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system They will also describe the movement of the Moon in relation to the Earth. They will describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies. Finally they will use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

<u>Topic- Our Big</u> <u>Question</u> How do locations in the world dictate time zones?

RE

This term the children will look at values and how they become codes for living. They will be able to identify ways people show that they are sorry. They will ask questions and make links about the way of life. They will describe and link up some Muslim teachings with how Muslims choose to live. The children will describe ways in which people try to increase peace.

PE

This term the children will be continuing to develop their dance skills: responding to music, learning simple sequences and responding to commands.

We will also be learning the rules and strategies for netball: passing, shooting and defending.
