

English and Reading

In English lessons we will be focussing on the book "Arthur and the golden rope" by Joe Todd-Stanton. We will be using the pictures and narrative from the book to help us write our own setting descriptions, and mythical narrative. We will be focusing on using, expanding noun phrases, fronted adverbials and prepositions.

Maths

During mathematics this term, children will be focussing on shape and perimeter, and multiplication and division up to or 12 times tables. We will be spending extra time across the day focusing on multiplication and division due to "The multiplication tables check" (MTC) towards the end of the year.



PSHE

In PSHE we will be discussing what are dreams and goals are, and what steps we need to take to try and archive these.

Grammar

With our grammar we will continue to build upon verb inflections, Nouns, prepositions and fronted adverbials. We will also be using a variety of nouns and pronouns to avoid repetition along with using inverted commas to indicate speech.
