We will be spending extra time across the day focusing on multiplication and division due to "The multiplication tables check" (MTC) towards the end of the year.

In PSHE we will be discussing what it means to be me in the world.

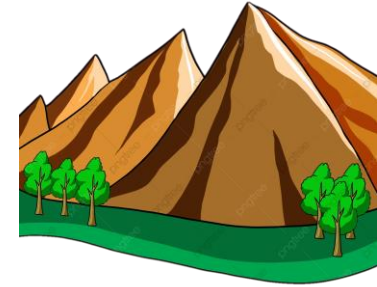
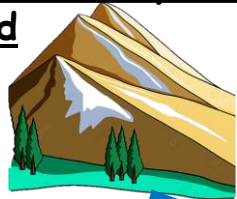
## Grammar
