# Online Safety

Follow the SMART rules to stay safe online

**S**

Stay **safe** online by not sharing personal information



**M**

Do not **meet** anyone who you have only made friends with online



**A**

Do not **accept** messages or friend requests from strangers



**R**

Not everything online is **reliable**. Some people online are strangers and may try and trick us



**T**

**Tell** an adult you trust if anything happens online that you don't like



Follow the **SMART** rules

Don't share personal information...if you wouldn't tell a stranger in the street then do not share!

Follow the **SMART** rules

Don't meet up!

Online games can be a great place to chat. Always know who you are talking to. Do not speak to adults that you do not know.

Follow the **SMART** rules

Think before accepting anything on-line, a file, a picture etc. It could contain a virus. If you don't know who an email is from and it has an attachment – **DELETE IT!**

Follow the **SMART** rules

Not everyone is reliable. They may be lying about their age, gender or who they are.

Know who you are talking to.



Follow the **SMART** rules

TELL a trusted adult if someone or something on-line makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.

Tell them if a friend needs help too.

You are playing your favourite game online and one of your friends starts to be unkind to you. They use bad language during the game and begin to call you names in the messages you send to each other afterwards. You are really upset and don't go on the website again, even though you don't want to stop playing because you're doing really well and getting high scores.
