

English and Reading

In English lessons we will be focusing on the story, Old Bear, by Jane Hissey. Children will read the story as a class and think about how to retell the story verbally. The children will work on building sentences and will have a go at rewriting parts of the story. We will also look at letter writing and how to send messages within a letter.

Maths

In Maths lessons we will be learning about Place Value.

We will be learning about:

- Counting one more

- Comparing groups

- Ordering groups of objects
- The number line



PSHE

In PSHE our theme will be, families and relationships. Children will understand families can be made up from different people. They will consider how friends may think or feel and recognise issues which may occur in friendships and that an adult may need to help resolve.

Grammar



We will look at making nouns plural by adding the suffix -s.

We will combine words to make sentences, trying to include 'and'.

We will sequence short sentences to form short narratives.

We will try to ensure that we use spaces between our words, use capital letters and full stops.



Class Beck Curriculum Overview- Term 1



ART/DT

In Art children will focus exploring and creating maps through various art forms, including drawing, felt making, printmaking, and designing stained glass. This to develop skills in sorting, designing, and evaluating art, encouraging students to present and discuss their creations in a class gallery setting.

Geography

In Geography children will investigate hot and cold areas of the world. We will use maps and globes when learning about the 7 continents and the 5 oceans around the world. We will think describe some similarities and differences between the UK and Kenya.

Science



In Science, children will match different plants and animals to their habitats and give examples of how animals use their habitat for food and shelter. They will recall that plants produce their own food for energy. Name living things that are producers and place a producer at the beginning of a food chain and use arrows to show the order in a food chain.

RE



In RE lessons we will be learning about Why are festivals important in a community? Looking at festivals from Christianity, Hindu Dharma, Islam, Judaism, Sikhi.

PE

Our first PE topic is multi-skills. The children will develop their throwing and catching skills, their ability to change direction with increasing speed and their ability to repeat and perform sequences of movement. We will also think about the importance of exercise and about how our bodies change during exercise.
