

English and Reading

In English lessons we will be focusing on the story, *Old Bear*, by Jane Hissey. Children will read the story as a class and think about how to retell the story verbally. The children will work on building sentences and will have a go at rewriting parts of the story. We will also look at letter writing and how to send messages within a letter.

Maths

In Maths lessons we will be learning about Place Value.

We will be learning about:

- Counting objects
- Representing objects
- Counting forwards and backwards
- Counting one more
- Counting one less
- Comparing groups
- < > and = symbols
- Ordering groups of objects
- The number line



PSHE

In PSHE our theme will be, *Being Me in My World*. We will think about what it means to belong to a class, understand that our class is a safe place to learn, and be proud of our achievements and those of others. We will think about our choices and feelings when faced with certain consequences.



Grammar

We will look at making nouns plural by adding the suffix -s.

We will combine words to make sentences, trying to include 'and'.

We will sequence short sentences to form short narratives.

We will try to ensure that we use spaces between our words, use capital letters and full stops.



Year 1 Curriculum Overview- Term 1

Topic- Arctic Adventure

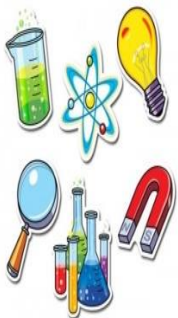


ART/DT

In Art we will be cutting, tearing and gluing a variety of materials, in order to create a collage of an Arctic scene. The children will investigate how temperature can be represented by colour.

Geography

In Geography children will investigate hot and cold areas of the world. We will use maps and Globes when learning about the 7 continents and the 5 oceans around the world. We will think about what it might be like to live in a different continent, collecting evidence from videos.



Science

In Science, children will consider different seasons and how weather changes. They will observe rainfall and temperature by collecting evidence and will record their findings within simple charts. Children will investigate how certain animals adapt to survive in different seasons.

RE



In RE lessons we will be learning about How to make good choices. We will be learning about the rules that Christians, Muslims, Buddhists and Sikhs follow to help them to make good choices.

PE

Our first PE topic is multi-skills. The children will develop their throwing and catching skills, their ability to change direction with increasing speed and their ability to repeat and perform sequences of movement. We will also think about the importance of exercise and about how our bodies change during exercise.
